

**Summer Village of Mewatha Beach
Bylaw 4/99**

A Bylaw of the Summer Village of Mewatha Beach, in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of establishing a position of designated officer and appointment of an Assessor.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act S.A. 1994, Chapter M-26.1 and amendments thereto, Section 210 (1) may establish one or more positions as a designated officer, and Section 284 (1) (d) indicates that an assessor is a duly qualified person who is appointed to the position of designated officer.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Mewatha Beach, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:

PART I: BYLAW TITLE

1. That this bylaw shall be known as the "Assessor Appointment" Bylaw.

PART II: PURPOSE OF BYLAW

1. The purpose of this bylaw is to authorize the position of designated officer, and to appoint a duly qualified assessor to that position.

PART III: DEFINITIONS

Assessor means a person who has the qualifications set out in the regulations and is appointed by the municipality to the position of designated officer to carry out the duties and responsibilities of an assessor under the Municipal Government Act, and includes any person to whom those duties and responsibilities are delegated by the person indicated herein.

Designated Officer means a person appointed to a position established under Section 210(1) of the Municipal Government Act S.A. 1994, Chapter M-26.1 and amendments thereto.

PART IV: DESIGNATED OFFICER

1. That the position of Designated Officer is established to be known as the "Assessor", for the purpose of providing for appointment of an Assessor to carry out the duties and responsibilities of an Assessor under the Municipal Government Act.

PART V: APPOINTMENT OF ASSESSOR

1. That Raymond (Ray) Crews, AMAA be appointed to the Designated Officer position as the Assessor to carry out the duties and responsibilities of the Assessor under the Municipal Government Act.
2. That the Assessor may delegate to any duly qualified person those duties and responsibilities referred to in paragraph (1) above.

This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the date of the passing of the Third and Final Reading and signing thereof.
