BY-LAW NO. 35-82

A BY-LAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF MEWATHA BEACH TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES WITH RESPECT TO UNPAID TAXES.


UNDER the authority and pursuant to the provisions of Sections 117 and 118 of the Municipal Taxation Act, being Chapter M-31 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980 and amendments thereto, the Council of the Summer Village of Mewatha Beach, duly assembled, enacts as follows:


1. That in the event the current years taxes levied remain unpaid after the expiry of ~~thirty (30)~~ <sup>forty (40)</sup> days of the date of mailing of the tax notice, there shall be added thereto by way of penalty, fifteen percent (15%) of the unpaid balance, but no such penalty shall be added thereto before the first day of July of the current year.
2. That in the event of any taxes remaining unpaid and outstanding after the thirty-first day of December, there shall be added thereto by way of penalty, fifteen percent (15%) of the unpaid balance on the first (1st) day of January of the next succeeding year and each succeeding year so long as the taxes remain unpaid.
3. Every amount so added by way of penalty shall form part of the unpaid taxes.
4. That this by-law rescinds By-law No. 1-78 and comes into effect on the day of its final passing.

READ a first time this 25 day of March, 1982

READ a second time this 25 day of March, 1982

READ a third time and finally passed this 25 day of March, 1982.
