

BY-LAW 71/90

A By-law of the Summer Village of Mewatha Beach, in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of designating Mewatha Drive, the east-west portion bordered by the Canadian National Railway, a controlled road and to control access to it, and rescind By-law 13/79.


WHEREAS THE Council deems it expedient and in the best interests of the Summer Village, to designate that portion of Mewatha Drive, being the east-west portion bordered by the Canadian National Railway as a controlled road as permitted by the Public Highways Development Act, and amendments and regulations thereto;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Mewatha Beach duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:


1. That the portion of Mewatha Drive described in the preamble, be designated as a controlled road;
2. That permitted accesses be:
 - (a) those road allowances shown on Plans 636 M.C. and 6737 N.Y.;
 - (b) lot 15, Block 2, Plan 636 M.C.;
 - (c) lots 2, 3 and 4, Block 3, Plan 636 M.C.;
 - (d) lot 1, Block 13, Plan 6737 N.Y.; and
 - (e) lots 1, 2, and 3, Block 17, Plan 6737 N.Y.
3. That no other access roads be permitted, without amendment to this By-law, and that By-law 13/79 be rescinded.





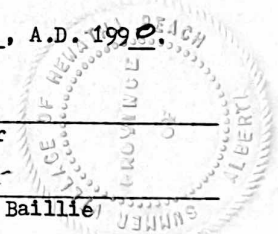
