A By-law of the Summer Village of Mewatha Beach, in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of amending and adding to the provisions of By-law 22/79, being the By-law for prevention, abatement and regulation of nuisances and unsightly or untidy premises, as previously amended by By-law 73/90.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Summer Village of Mewatha Beach, deems it expedient and in the best interests of the Summer Village to provide for a regulation relating to the storage of garbage, refuse and or waste material within the Summer Village;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Mewatha Beach, duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That By-law 22/79 be amended by adding paragraph 3 (a) immediately following paragraph 3;
- 2. Paragraph 3 (a) to read;

"It shall be an offence under this By-law to store garbage, refuse, waste material, or other substances, which may be attractive to wild or domestic animals, for a period in excess of 72 hours in or on any unoccupied, either temporarily or otherwise, property within the Summer Village, subject to the following:

"Material as described above, may be stored in the main dwelling on the owners property, provided it is impervious to entry by any animal."

3. That this By-law shall have effect from the date of third reading.

Read a 1st time this 24th day of November A.D. 1990. Read a 2nd time this 24th day of November A.D. 1990.

With unanamious consent of Council, read a 3rd time this 24th day of November A.D. 1990 and passed.
