Projects

We have a few projects planned for this summer;

- The installation of a culvert in the area of Park Lane and Lakeview drive onto the Municipal Reserve to alleviate flooding issues in this area. (Grant Funding)
- Small build up of the road on Starling to correct a drainage issue. (Grant Funding)
- Replacing the crushed culvert on Elm Way. (Grant Funding)
- Creation of a swale along the back of the properties on Birch Road backing on to the new park. The swale will run behind the properties and aid in carrying water directing to the lake which should help with flooding in this area. (Grant Funding)
- Repair to Mewatha Drive at the North West end (Warranty Work)
- Calcium dust control will be applied to the laneways around the week of June 7.
- The gate on the road going down to the beach will be altered to allow access for strollers and wheelchairs.
- A concrete ramp is being added to the new outhouse to allow better wheelchair access.
- Blue Spruce will be removing some trees in the village that have been reported and flagged.
 If you know of any trees on summer village property that should be removed please let Kim know prior to June 15.
- Some adjustments are being made to the gazebo on the beach to complete the outside and repair some misaligned posts.



Fire Bans
