
Athabasca Regional Waste Annual Fire Smart Round Up and Appliance Round Up

Projects

We have a few projects planned for this summer;

- Some improvements to the Beach area; New Buoys, New Picnic Tables and Benches. The pathway to the beach through the trees will be cleared to provide better access. (Grant Funding)
- Adding a small dock to the boat launch. This docks is for temporary tie ups only. No boat mooring is permitted. (Grant Funding)
- Improvement of the Pathway on Shady Lane (Grant Funding)
- Adding Emergency address signs to each lot. This will help improve the ability for emergency services to find properties in the Summer Village. They are being placed on Summer Village Property (Road Allowance) and you are not permitted to remove or relocate them. (Grant Funding)
- Routine Road Repairs and painted stop lines at the 4-Way Stop.
- Calcium dust control will be applied to the County Road leading into the Summer Village. (Grant Funding).



Fire Bans

Just a reminder to check the fire sign at each entrance to the village to see if there are any fire restrictions. Please remember that fireworks are strictly forbidden during a fire ban. For more information please visit www.albertafirebans.ca

Littering

In past years, littering at the top of the beach parking lot has been an issue. We are adding an additional bear proof garbage bin at the top of the parking lot.

Bears are always an issue in the summer village. Please take proper precautions to prevent this. Ensure that all garbage is secured tightly and that all animal feed is locked away in buildings or in bear proof containers. This includes any bird feeders. Report bear sightings, especially aggressive behavior to 1-800-642-3800.
